Lynn Compton and her extreme colleagues on the Board of Supervisors are at it again. This Tuesday, they will likely approve a radical redrawing of supervisor district boundaries in order to preserve their power.

The district map they favor (called the Patten Map) breaks up many communities of interest throughout the county. It especially targets South County, rearranging District 4 solely to keep Lynn Compton in power.

The Patten Map would sever Oceano from Nipomo and Arroyo Grande despite their common interests, including agriculture, the Oceano Dunes, and a large Latino population.

Remember that Lynn Compton barely eked out a victory in 2018, beating me by only 60 votes. If she has to play by the same rules, she is afraid she will lose to me next time. She believes the Patten Map would improve her odds.

In cutting Oceano from District 4, she removes a community that voted overwhelmingly for me in 2018. In adding Edna Valley, she will pick up voters who she hopes might give her a winning margin.

But let's be honest. South County voters don't believe in gaming the system. We are confident that they will hold Lynn Compton accountable – for this foul play and other shenanigans.

## Attend Tuesday's Redistricting Hearing

The Board of Supervisors will have its **final redistricting hearing 9 a.m. Tuesday (tomorrow)**, at the SLO County Government Center (1055 Monterey St, SLO). The Board will select one map to go forward as the new district boundaries. It's important to put on the record as many objections to the Patten Map as possible.

### What you can do:

- **Email the Supervisors** at [boardofsup@co.slo.ca.us](mailto:boardofsup@co.slo.ca.us): In your own words, state your concerns. Be brief and civil. Be sure to sign your email using your formal voter registration name.
- **Attend the meeting**: It's important that the Supervisors know that citizens care. Showing up is way more valuable than sending an email. Please do both if you can.

- **Speak at the meeting:** Speaking is most valuable of all. Giving public comment can feel intimidating to some, but even a brief statement with your concerns goes a long way.


