At Tuesday night's candidate debate sponsored by the SLO County Citizens Commission on Homelessness, Lynn Compton spoke volumes – by not showing up.

Why she chose not to talk about homelessness, one of our most pressing issues, is baffling.

Homelessness has only worsened during her eight years as a county supervisor, so maybe she didn't want to admit that she has no ideas, no practical solutions to offer.
