You've probably seen Lynn Compton's ads that accuse me of raising taxes 15 times as an Arroyo Grande City Council member (false), voting to increase my pay (false), and fining people \$500 for failing to wear a mask (false). All false.

Here's the truth:

About Taxes: Lynn Compton is trying to deceive you. Taxes can be raised only by a vote of the people. Plain and simple. No city council member is able to unilaterally vote to raise taxes. Not 15 times, not ever.

About Council Pay: I voted *TWICE* against giving City Council members a raise, but I was in the minority.

About Mask Fines: Nobody was fined for failing to wear a mask. At the police department's request, we approved an ordinance that allowed police to issue a fine instead of making an arrest (their only option under the law at the time). No person was ever fined. Period.

Not only is Lynn Compton spewing these falsehoods, so is a political action committee funded with \$30,000 from just one Nipomo developer.

That's right – one developer, \$30,000. He happens to be the developer behind the massive Dana Reserve project in Nipomo. This controversial project – which needs Supervisors' approval – calls for 3,400 mature oak trees to be cut down to make room for 1,300 new housing units, many of them luxury homes, with water issues still unresolved.

I want you to know: **While Lynn Compton has taken \$150,000 in campaign donations from big developers, I haven't taken a dime from them.** For me, it's a matter of transparency and accountability. I don't accept developers' money because I believe their projects should rise or fall on the project's merits. I don't want anyone to think my vote can be bought – any project I vote on will be based on an objective review, considering and balancing all of the interests.

It's sad that Lynn Compton thinks she needs to disparage me to win votes for herself. But she can't run on her eight-year record of doing nothing while homelessness rose and water supplies dwindled.

You deserve a County Supervisor who tells the truth and fights for you, not for special interests.

When I'm elected, here's what I will work to do:

- Generate new sources of water to preserve our quality of life.
- Expand supportive housing, mental health services, and drug and alcohol treatment to keep homeless people safely off our streets.
- Help businesses and farms thrive so South County residents have good-paying jobs, and our economy remains strong.
- Make our streets safer by fully funding police budgets, adding a sheriff's substation and increasing patrols.
- Improve our roads to reduce time spent in traffic.

I am running to make sure your government works for you. I respectfully ask for your vote.
